a: Accelerated programs are typically completed in three years; therefore, students should consider total program tuition when comparing accelerated programs to traditional programs.

b: First year fees include the cost of an iPad or laptop.

c: Student health fee may be waived.

d: Fees include the cost of a laptop and preloaded software.

e: Reported fees do not include \$3,499 required health insurance fee. Fee may be waived if student can demonstrate other health insurance coverage.

f: Residents of MA, NH, VT, and ME are eligible for a reduced tuition rate of \$19,366 per year and a mandatory fee of \$2,842 per year for the first professional year.

g: Tuition and fees reported are an estimate. Please contact the school directly for more information.

h: Reported fees include a \$1,140 health insurance fee which may be waived if the

student can demonstrate other health insurance coverage; fees include a public transportation pass but do not apply to students at the Rockford campus.

i: Students may apply for in-state residency after one year of Ohio employment.

j: Kentucky and Indiana residents in certain counties are eligible for a special metropolitan rate which is less than non-resident tuition. Please see [http://www.uc.edu/registrar/residency\\_reciprocity\\_metro.html](http://www.uc.edu/registrar/residency_reciprocity_metro.html).

k: Florida in-state tuition for Bradenton, FL campus is \$22,475 per year, non-resident tuition is \$25,709 per year, and mandatory fees are \$905 per year. 32 semester credit hours are taken in the first professional year.

l: Distance Education Pathway cost for in-state and non-resident is \$25,030 and mandatory fees are \$1,850 per year. 32 semester credit hours are taken in the first professional year.

m: Mandatory fees are included in yearly tuition cost.

n: Non-resident students pay an additional \$625 capital outlay fee.
