- m: Program structure is 0-6 (no prepharmacy requirements), but also take transfer students in the third year (professional year 1)
- n: 0-7 (no prepharmacy requirements); 72+ semester hours required for admission for non-0-7 students to backfill
- o: Ursuline College/University of Toledo Partnership & Owens Community College/University of Toledo Partnership
- p: Weekend Pharm.D. requires a Baccalaureate Degree
- q: Distance Education Pathway
- r: Students living in the Rio Grande Valley and Laredo regions of Texas may become part of the Cooperative Pharmacy programs between UT Austin and UT Rio Grande Valley.
- s: MCW offers unique reverse transfer degree options with Carrol University, St. Norbert College, and Wisconsin Lutheran College. These programs allow you to earn a BS/BA and PharmD in just 6 years.
